The Richard Stockton College of New Jersey is ranked among the top ten small Masters granting institutions in the northeast. It is located in southern New Jersey on 1600 acres about one hour from Philadelphia, two hours from New York City, and 20 minutes from Atlantic City. The College has a diverse array of undergraduate programs in the sciences and mathematics, and has recently initiated new programs at the master's level. The School of Natural Sciences and Mathematics (NAMS) presently occupies over 50,000 NSF on the College's campus in Pomona, NJ and an eight acre Marine and Environmental Field Station (including the Coastal Research Center) in nearby Port Republic, NJ. We are seeking outstanding candidates for the position of Assistant Dean/Director for Academic Laboratories and Field Facilities who will show spark, insight, and commitment to join us as we embark on the conclude the design phase and begins construction of a 66,000 NSF square foot Unified Science Center as Stockton launches its 40th anniversary.

A Ph.D. (preferred) in Biology, Biochemistry, or Chemistry or Masters + PE certification in Chemical Engineering plus at least five years of management experience particularly in an academic environment plus a working knowledge of OSHA Laboratory Standards, the safe handling of chemical and radioactive materials, current Right-To-Know regulations required and an understanding of NIH animal use and care practices. The Director is responsible for the administration and management of laboratories and field facilities in all science disciplines; supervises eight full time and nine part time professional employees; enforces and designs safety and operational procedures; functions as the NAMS' Chemical Hygiene and the College's Radiation Safety officer; monitors and maintains NAMS' budgets, initiates and approves purchasing of equipment and supplies; coordinates facility renovations; and will have direct oversight in the construction of the Science Center; is responsible for NAMS' chemical inventory database and implementation of NAMS' Right-To-Know training. The Director will be expected to interact with the College's Office of Risk Management and Environmental Health and Safety Physical Plant and Facilities Planning and the Campus Police Department.
