DESCRIPTION:

This position is responsible for developing and coordinating the implementation of chemical spill prevention and response programs, chemical waste collection, processing, treatment and disposal programs and other related environmental compliance programs. General duties include responding to chemical releases, monitoring affected work areas, collecting and processing chemical waste, developing and conducting in-service training for the University community and coordinating with outside agencies, community members and contractors.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

A Bachelor's degree involving major study in occupational safety and/or health, industrial hygiene, chemistry, physics, chemical, mechanical OR sanitary engineering, environmental science, nursing, medicine, biology, OR related field AND Three years of experience as an industrial hygienist; OR equivalent education/experience.

LOCATION: Washington State University, Pullman, Washington
